Dress Code Descriptions

Casual — Jeans, shorts, t-shirts and golf shirts are all acceptable. Outdoor Casual suggests you add a jacket, sunscreen, insect repellent and runners or good walking shoes.

Golf Attire — Tailored shorts or long pants are acceptable. Proper golf shirts are required (no tank tops or bare midriffs). Blue jeans are not allowed. All golf shoes must have soft spikes or running shoe style soles.

Formal Wear — Ladies may choose to wear a cocktail dress or a full length dress. A dark business suit with a tie is appropriate for any gentleman not wishing to wear a tuxedo.

Children’s Activity Program

Children must wear a “stick-on” name tag and wear clothing appropriate for activities involving glue and paint. Children should bring/wear a jacket and appropriate footwear in the event that the group goes outdoors (weather permitting) for a short stargazing walk.
